CAL OES- FEMA – (Submitted 08/04/2023) PCFSC has partnered with Plumas County to apply for this grant. Roughly \$2.6 million was asked for to use for home hardening efforts in Plumas County. We are working with the county to meet the matching requirements for this grant. This grant awaits Kristi Noem’s (head of DHS) signature to move forward with the project.

CAL FIRE Forest Health Grant - Initial Application Phase. PCFSC is partnering with FRRCD to apply for HFR and Planting work in Eastern Plumas County. Approximately \$5.7 million was applied for to treat 1,946.6-acres of private land from the base of Grizzly Rd (on Sierra Nevada Journeys property) to the North Portola area, as well as Clover Valley Ranch further North. Applicants will be notified if they have been invited to submit a full application by 04/27/2026.

CAL FIRE Forest Health Grant - Initial Application Phase. PCFSC is partnering with Terra Fuego and the Forest Service to apply for prescribed fire work on public lands. Approximately \$7.8 million was applied for to treat 7,000-acres of public land with Prescribed Fire. This application was submitted by Terra Fuego with PCFSC/Plumas Corp providing fiscal/grant tracking and reporting support. Applicants will be notified if they have been invited to submit a full application by 04/27/2026.

WRTC PBA Coordinator Funds - Logan is applying for funds for Plumas Underburn Cooperative Coordination time. Approximately \$100k is being asked for to support a new PUC Manager next Fiscal Year. Applicants will be notified by May 1st.

PG&E FSC HFR Grant – PCFSC was not selected for this grant. Darrell has applied for a PG&E grant for \$99,586 to fund contracting and staff time for a 2026 round of the Community Chipping Program. Awards will likely be announced by early March.

RAC Grant – a Rural Advisory Committee (RAC) is needed to be able to process future grant applications. Here is the [Federal Register Notice](#) about the membership requirements for county RACs and the [web page for RACs](#). The last time period for recruiting new members ended in April 2025. [There is a charter](#) that sets the policies and procedures for the committees.
